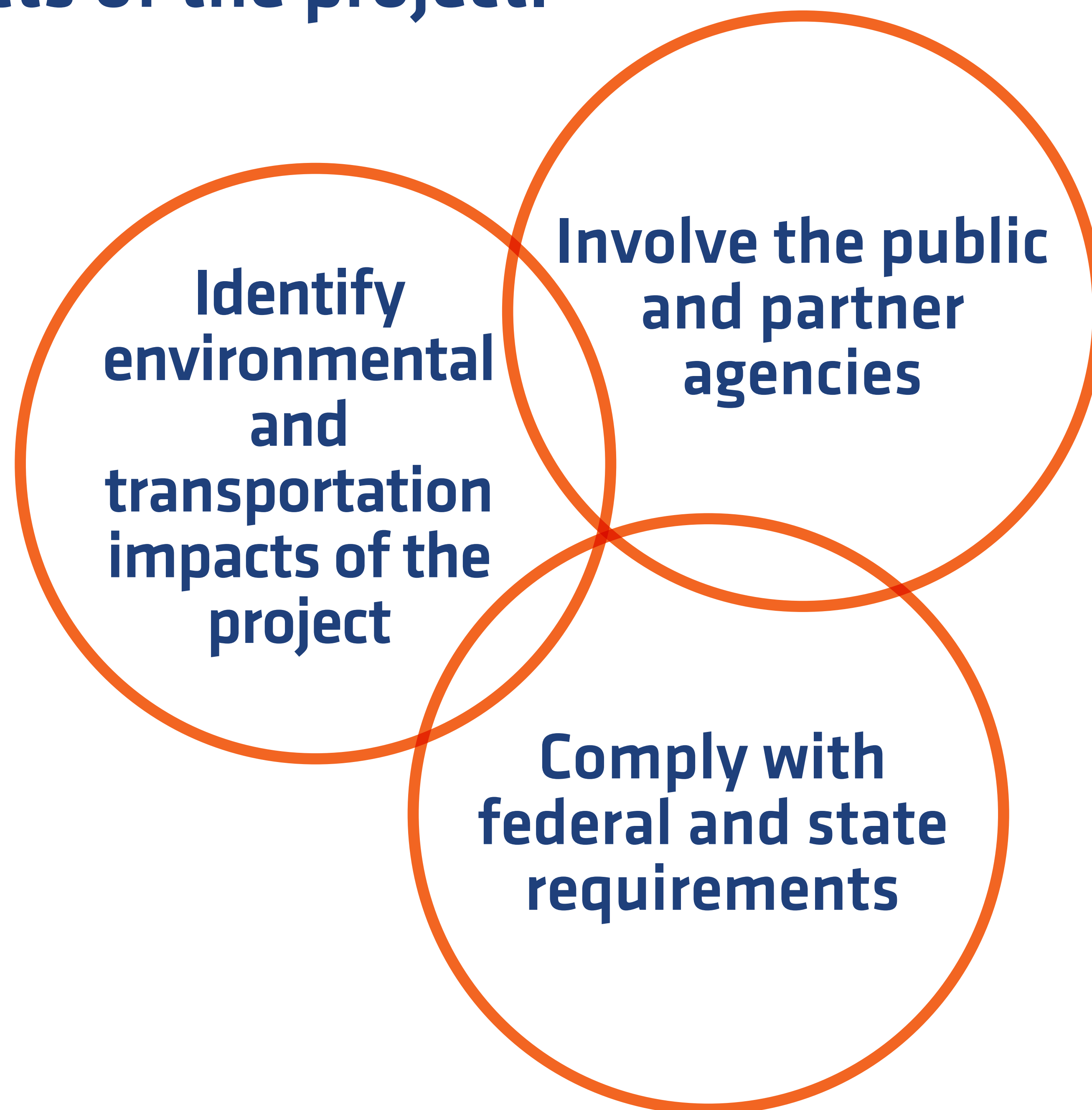


Environmental Process
